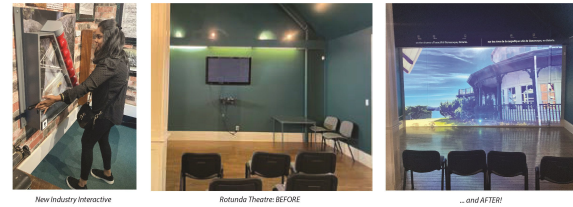

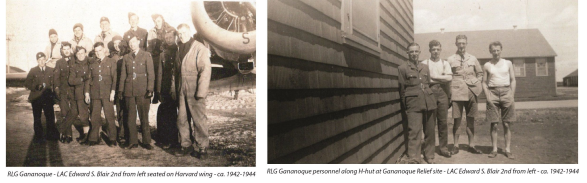


News from the Town of Gananoque's Historic Collection
